BISHOP'S LENTEN MESSAGE 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I wish you abiding peace, joy and well-being in the Lord!

Our Southern African Catholic Bishops Conference is celebrating 75 years of its existence this year. On Sunday 22nd January 2023 the Bishops and the Faithful of the Archdiocese of Pretoria came together at the Catholic Church of the Beatitudes to celebrate this important achievement.

It was also decided that the Bishops would prepare short reflections throughout this Lenten Season as an expression of the synodal Church that journeys together in communion, with the participation of all the baptised as missionary disciples. The daily reflections from the Secretariat in Khanya House is shared with all Parishes in the Diocese and is also available on “Catholic Diocese of Port Elizabeth” Facebook page .

Lent leads to Easter: the “retreat” is not an end in itself, but a means of preparing us to experience the Lord’s passion and cross with faith, hope and love, and thus to arrive at the resurrection. Also, on the synodal journey, when God gives us the grace of certain powerful experiences of communion, we should not imagine that we have arrived – for there too, the Lord repeats to us: “Rise, do not be afraid”. Let us go down, then, to the plain, and may the grace we have experienced strengthen us to be “artisans of synodality” in the ordinary life of our communities.

Dear Brothers and Sisters, may the Holy Spirit inspire and sustain us this Lent in our ascent with Jesus, so that we may experience his divine splendour and thus, confirmed in faith, persevere in our journey together with him, glory of his people and light of the nations. (Message of the Holy Father for Lent 2023)

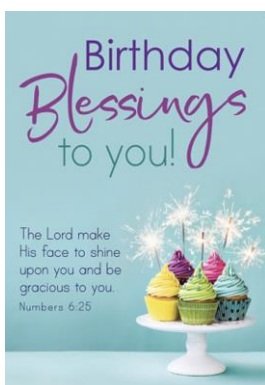

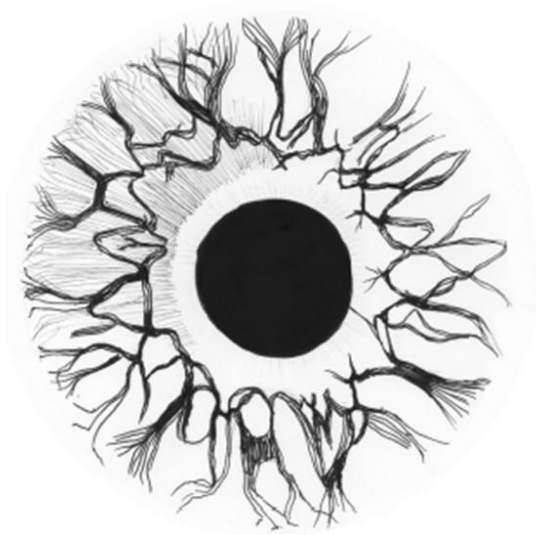
What is the Catholic synod 2022?

What a joy it is to be back to almost normal gathering and worship patterns after the restrictions of the past couple of years. Despite loadshedding and water restrictions we are still holding to hope and trust as we go on in 2023.

The Carols by Candlelight was back in 2022, and what a beautiful celebration of cultural diversity we had within one common belief and faith. We had a variety of languages, mix of age groups and such melodious voices. This format of the Carol celebration was introduced in 2016 as we celebrated the 150th anniversary, but in my view the presentation on 9th December 2022 was like an explosion of prayerful joy and delight released after the shut downs and restrictions of the past 3 years.

The parish CWL combined strengths with the parish conference of SVDP and provided a sit down home cooked meal for 100 needy people, most of whom are homeless on the various streets, derelict buildings and parks in and around central. Reflecting on this event several aspects were striking. The generosity of the ordinary parishioners who responded so quickly to the call to join in and participate. On the first weekend of the request, we already had volunteers for all the dishes of cottage pie, rice and vegetables that were needed. With the additional cash donations all costs were covered. With the 100 people that came, there were no squabbles, disagreements or incidents between the people. It was heart rending to see how concerned some were to make sure that their bags, basket, trolley were protected by our helpers outside. Everything that they own has to go with them night and day. It was a privilege to be part of the event.

2023 has got off to an enthusiastic start. The born-day/birthday thanksgiving Mass on the last weekend of each month, is received warmly. All those who have celebrated a birthday in the month are invited for a special blessing on the last Sunday of the month, many like to make a thanksgiving donation, representing their thanksgiving for their lives so far. It is touching to be reminded each month to be thankful for our lives.

The catechetics program moved towards the end of 2022 to Sunday mornings after Mass, after years of being on Wednesday afternoons at 17h00. The attendance has grown beyond belief, the stream of our young people, from 17 yr. olds to tots that run up to join their catechists is a symbol of hope and joy. It seems to be easier for parents and catechists and a bonus is we can all enjoy tea/coffee and biscuits while the children are in their classes.

Our CWL ladies are fantastic and working away supporting every aspect of parish

life. In December a member raised R2000 + for the sick priest's fund. What a delight that one of parishioners, Rosemary Bouwer won it. Now after the traditional pancake evening on Shrove Tuesday we have Fish and chips on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.

Our resident priest, Fr. Jerry, celebrated his 60th birthday on 26th February and the parish marked it on Friday 24th with a dance and dinner in the MacSherry Hall and tea and cake for all the February Birthday/anniversary celebrants on Sunday 26th. The celebration on the Friday evening was a wonderful and joyful event, enjoyed by parishioners from all our community groups and friends from Mater Dei, Uitenhage, Retrouvaille and elsewhere. We were delighted to welcome his 4 siblings Jim, Joan, Jack and Donald and friends, some for a first visit to Africa among us. Congratulations Fr. During January our Soup Kitchen handed out 244 cups of soup and 22 loaves of bread.

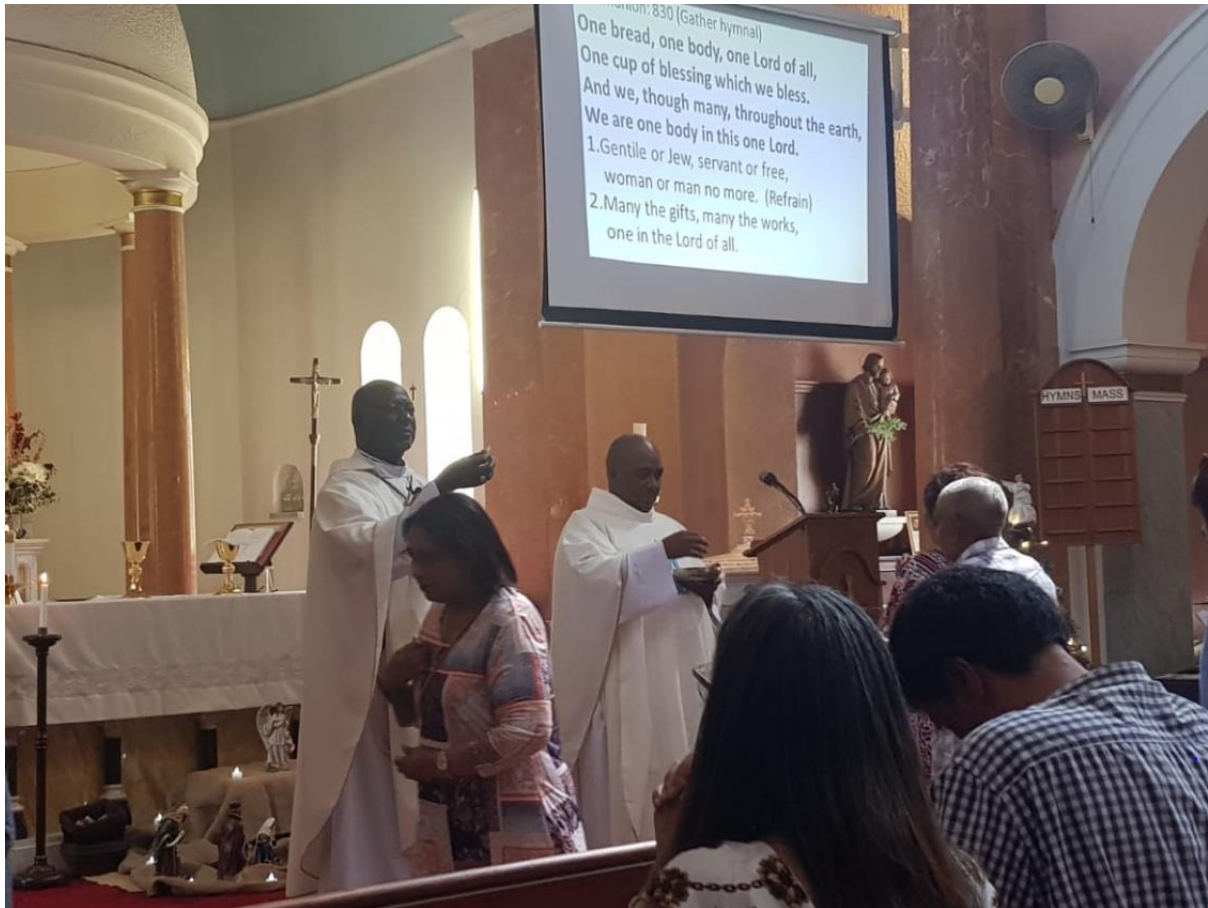
The food pantry provided 68 parcels to the less privileged and 4 families in need.

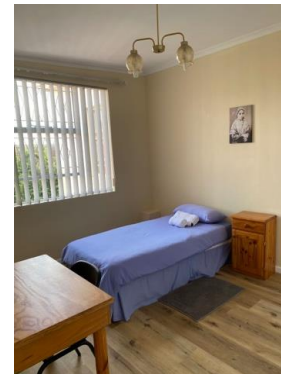

Sunday Mass is held at St Luke's Chapel at 9 am and the involvement of the youth in the Mass is a critical part of their growth in the faith.

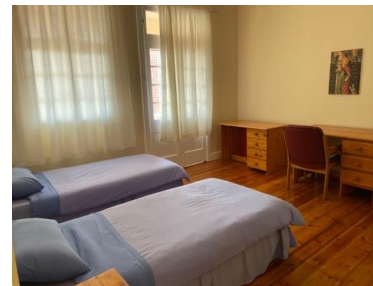
The goal is to grow this student community into a home group which under the guidance of a spiritual mentor will grow together in the faith, encourage each other and teach other each other.

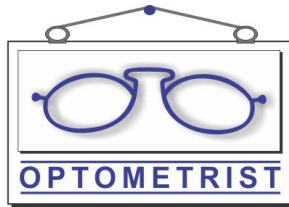
