FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER – YEAR C – 14/15 MAY 2022

The Lord is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

In the gospel for the Fifth Sunday of Easter we reflect on the commandment of love: “A new commandment I give you,” says the Lord, “that you love one another as I have loved you” (cf. John 13:34). Love is the distinguishing mark of Easter people!

Like the Apostles in the early church, the priests and missionaries of the Neo-Catechumenal Way are among us for the **Easter Mission**, which started on Wednesday, 4 May 2022, at 19h00 in the Hall, and will continue on Mondays and Fridays until Pentecost. All parishioners are invited to attend this Mission, so that we may be spiritually renewed in this **Parish Jubilee Year**.

MONTH OF MARY – PRAY THE ROSARY FOR WORLD PEACE: The month of May, in our Catholic Tradition, is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. All the faithful, families and communities, are invited to pray the Rosary throughout May. We encourage all families of our parish to choose a suitable time of the day when they can gather for the Rosary in the home. A large poster will be displayed in the foyer throughout the month where individuals and families can inscribe their names if they would like to participate in this initiative, dedicating a daily decade or a daily or weekly Rosary, praying for peace in the world/in the family.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE AND RECONCILIATION (CONFESSION): Saturdays, 16h15-16h45.

TUESDAY EVENING ROSARY AND MASS: is dedicated to prayer for families of the parish. **Families are encouraged to choose at least one Tuesday in the month to come and pray as a family with the larger community to which we all belong.** A simple Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place between 17h30 and 18h30. THURSDAY ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: to grow in our devotion to Jesus Christ, really and truly present in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar, there is an opportunity to participate in the Holy Hour on Thursdays, after the 08:30am Mass.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL (PPC): the Sacred Heart PPC has been at the helm for the past four years and therefore the time has come to elect a new one as per Diocesan Policy. What is a PPC? *It is a consultative body that serves to advise the parish priest about pastoral issues. The council's main purpose is to investigate, reflect and reach conclusions about pastoral matters to recommend to the parish priest.* Nominations will take place during all Masses this weekend – any registered/confirmed parishioner is able to nominate a candidate for the new PPC; once the nominations have been collected, the Parish Office will contact the candidates to affirm their acceptance of nomination.
